Progress

As of 1 Dec. 2016, **3548** publications resulting from research and communication funded by the NCP, have been added to the NCP Publications Database. This includes **1203** papers in the *Synopsis of Research* volumes, **972** journal papers, and **1271** other publications.

Publications available on the Web are **hyperlinked**: **2201** records have URLs that take you directly to the PDF files of the publications.

932 of the 972 journal papers have **DOIs** (digital object identifiers) or URLs, which are hyperlinked. Clicking on the link will take you to the publisher's website and, if your organization has a subscription, to a PDF file of the paper.

ORCID Identifiers

The Northern Contaminants Program requests all NCP Researchers obtain an Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID). ORCIDs provide a way to uniquely identify researchers' records in Canadian polar databases and will allow easy cross-linking of records between the NCP's website and the NCP Publications Database. They are also increasingly being required for publication submission.
