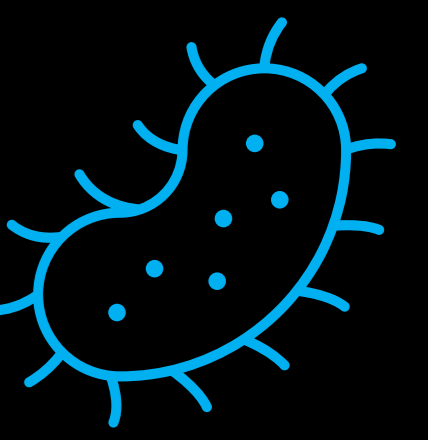
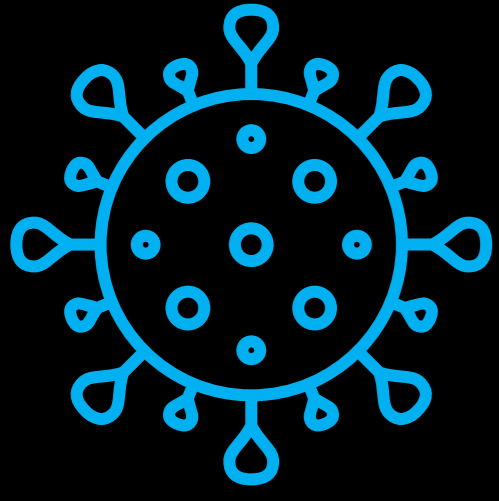
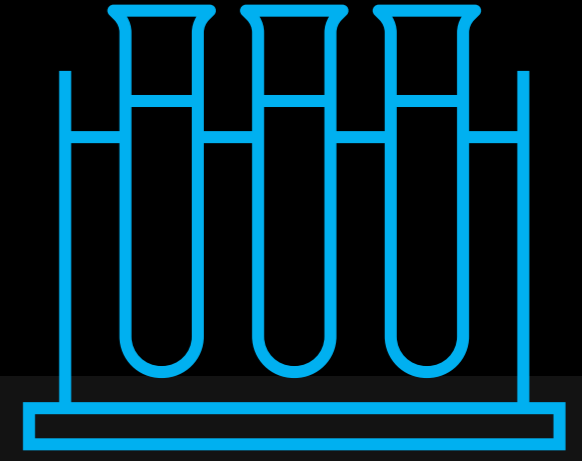


# The NCP Publications Database

The NCP Publications Database is an initiative to make publications resulting from Northern Contaminants Program projects easily discoverable and accessible.

In operation since 2003, the NCP Publications Database project aims to:

- Support awareness of contaminants in the North from long-range sources and the work that is underway to address the issue by making NCP publications discoverable and accessible in the NCP Publications Database, the Arctic Science and Technology Information System (ASTIS), and the Canadian Consortium for Arctic Data Interoperability (CCADI) system.
- Help support the food choice decisions among consumers of traditional/country foods by making NCP publications on this topic accessible in the database.
- Build capacity in the North to participate in and/or contribute to addressing these issues by ensuring that community members can easily discover and access information on this subject in the database, including, as needed, providing webinars and training workshops on database use.


## Progress

As of 30 November 2022, **4,628** publications resulting from research and communication funded by the Northern Contaminants Program, have been added to the NCP Publications Database. This includes **1,452** papers in the *Synopsis of Research* volumes, **1,262** journal papers, and **1,914** other publications.

Publications available on the Web are **hyperlinked**: **2,455** records have URLs that take you directly to the **PDF** files of the publications.

**1,117** of the 1,262 journal papers have **DOIs** (digital object identifiers) or URLs, which are hyperlinked. Clicking on the link will take you to the publisher's website and, if your organization has a subscription, to a PDF file of the paper.

### ORCID Identifiers

The Northern Contaminants Program requests all NCP Researchers obtain an Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID). ORCIDs provide a way to uniquely identify researchers' records in Canadian polar databases and will allow easy cross-linking of records between the NCP's website and the NCP Publications Database. They are also increasingly being required for publication submission.
